

The Board of Trustees has adopted a policy of locating fire extinguishers inside classroom doors, with a sign outside indicating the location of the extinguisher. The Board of Trustees directs that the door shall remain unlocked when the classroom is occupied.

It is further provided that this policy must be approved by the fire department serving each school before it shall be effective at that school. This policy is established due to frequent theft of fire extinguishers.
