## More Water Bottle Filling Stations Come to AUHSD September 16, 2019

The Maintenance and Operations Department is pleased to share with you its plan to install more water bottle filling stations at our schools. Thanks to the efforts of our District's Energy Manager, Juliann Ferguson, Anaheim Public Utility has approved funding of \$35,000 to install one bottle filling station at each of the following schools: Western High School, Orangeview Junior High School, Ball Junior High School, Sycamore Junior High School, Savanna High School, and Anaheim High School.

This funding allows the District to direct District maintenance funding to allow for installation of water bottle filling stations outside of the Anaheim Public Utility service area.

The Maintenance and Operations staff will soon be in communication with site administration to schedule the installation of these stations in a strategic location that is easily accessible to our students and staff.
