

- ✓ \$2,500 for a high school senior
- ✓ \$2,500 for a post-secondary school student
- ✓ Additional amounts to be awarded to runners-up

One of the recipients will be entered into the Association for Community Affiliated Plans (ACAP) National Leadership Program for the opportunity to win an additional \$5,000.

ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY SUNDAY, MAY 1, 2022

Scholarship awards will be funded solely through fundraising activities conducted by CalOptima employees. No public money will be used.




