

Creating Your Federal Student Aid (FSA) ID

Important: Please confirm this information with your parent/guardian prior to 2/8/22.

- Federal Student Aid (FSA) IDs are **required** for students and parents to participate in the Pledge and to complete the FAFSA application online.
- A Dream Act Application must be submitted for students who do not have a Social Security #. Dreamers do not need to create an FSA ID. Here is a link to create a Parent PIN for Dream Act Application signatures - <https://dream.csac.ca.gov/parent>

What You Will Need To Create Your FSA ID

- ☐ YOUR PERSONAL EMAIL ADDRESS (Not AUHSD)
The email address must be **unique to each individual**. You will not be able to use the same email for you and your parents. Do NOT use your auhsd email.
- ☐ YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER **OR** YOUR ALIEN REGISTRATION NUMBER **OR** ITIN
- ☐ YOUR BIRTH DATE
- ☐ YOUR NAME EXACTLY AS IT IS ON YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY CARD OR YOUR ALIEN REGISTRATION CARD
- ☐ MAILING ADDRESS
- ☐ PHONE NUMBER


