Each year, this team replaces upward of 30,000 lineal feet of irrigation pipe, and more than 200,000 lineal feet of wiring to connect the irrigation system to the controller. These tasks require hours of effort and diligence as they require the use of landscaping equipment to excavate grounds while ensuring that utility lines remain intact. In addition, this crew is responsible for the replacement of backflows, valves, sprinklers, pumps, motors, as well as addressing any irrigation emergencies throughout the year.
