Pledge Requirements

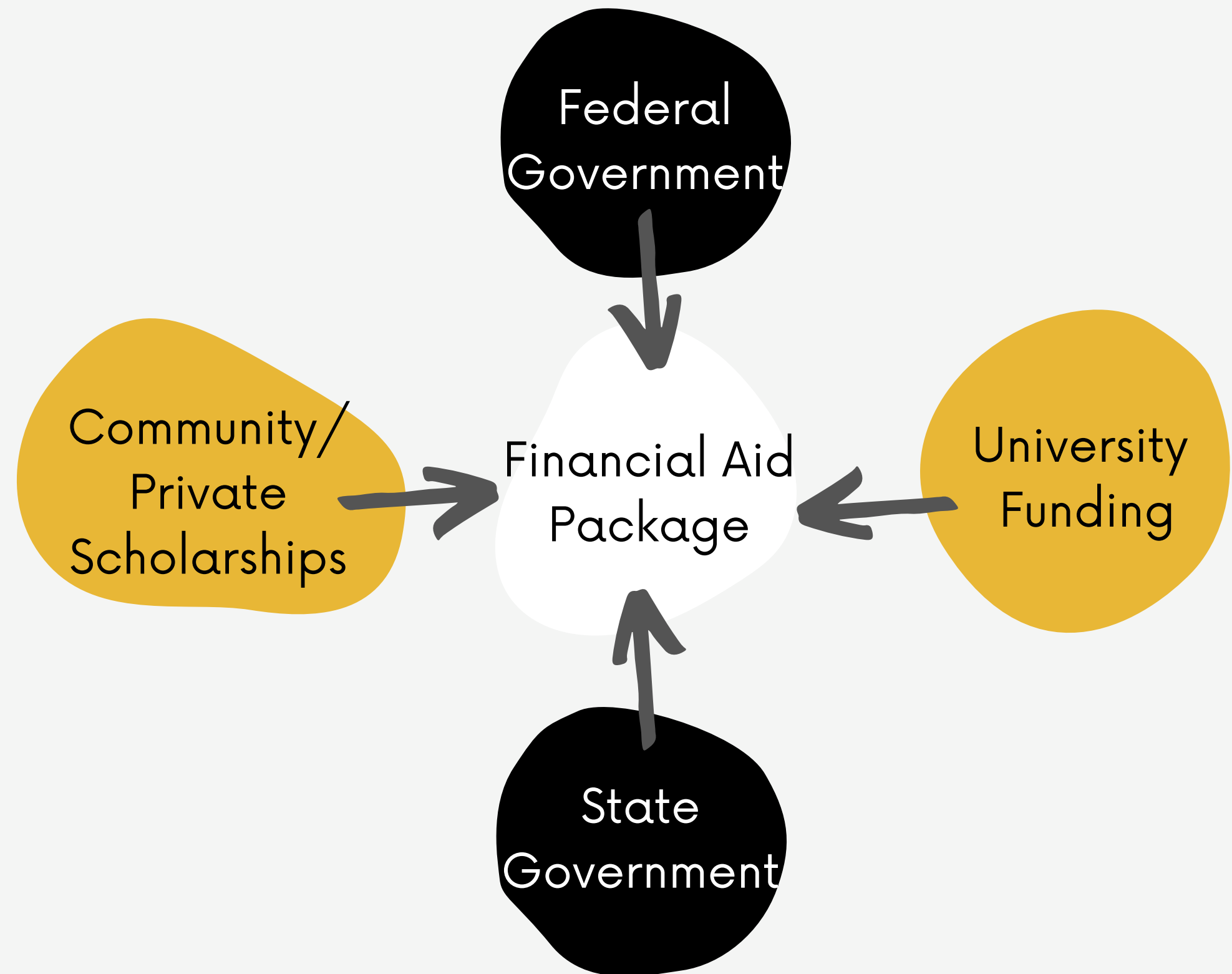
In order to qualify for the Pledge and get **FREE** tuition, you **MUST** complete a financial aid application.

- Complete a **FAFSA application** if you have a Social Security Number.

Financial Aid

Part 1:

- Create your FSA ID, if you have a social security number.
 - FSA ID = your electronic signature that you need to complete your Financial Aid Application (FAFSA Only)
- In order to create your FSA ID, you need to...
 - Have/create a personal email address (not your AUHSD email)
 - Gather important information
 - See the handout and talk to your parent/guardian
 - Bring your completed handout tomorrow!

YOU WILL BE CREATING YOUR FSA ID IN CLASS, BE PREPARED!

Creating Your FSA ID

WHAT YOU NEED:

- YOUR PERSONAL EMAIL ADDRESS (Not AUHSD)
The email address must be unique to each individual. You will not be able to use the same email for you and your parents. Do NOT use your auhsd email.
- YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OR YOUR ALIEN REGISTRATION NUMBER OR ITIN
- YOUR BIRTH DATE
- YOUR NAME EXACTLY AS IT IS ON YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY CARD OR YOUR ALIEN REGISTRATION CARD
- MAILING ADDRESS
- PHONE NUMBER

Financial Aid

Part 2:

- Scan the QR code on the handout and sign up one of the workshops.

 - Last year's Tax Return
 - Social Security Number (if applicable)
 - Alien Registration Number (if applicable)
